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


Fig. 1: Example of Robotic arm working model




Fig. 2: Proposed system hardware working block diagram

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


Fig. 3: Execution, processing flow of proposed system and implementation process




Fig. 4: Image processing algorithm flow

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




Fig. 5: Pixel colour extraction method




Fig. 6: Proposed system hardware with Control and Power Unit
